- Some medications contribute to decreased salivary gland function resulting in xerostomia (dry mouth) increasing risk of tooth decay and gum disease.

- **Good oral health** improves the quality of life.
- **A healthy mouth** improves overall general health, makes people more comfortable, aids speech, aids digestion, and boosts morale and self esteem with clean healthy teeth.
- **Removal of oral bacteria** through brushing, flossing and denture care can reduce the incidence of heart and lung disease, diabetes, and serious infections such as aspiration pneumonia.
